Online Applications are invited from Indian Citizens and such other nationals as declared eligible by the Government of India for recruitment to the posts of i) Assistant Professor in Psychiatric Epidemiology in IOP (Institute of Psychiatry), a Centre of Excellence, Kolkata & ii) Demonstrator in Psychiatric Epidemiology in IOP (Institute of Psychiatry), a Centre of Excellence, Kolkata in **West Bengal Medical Education Service** under the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal.

Online Registration will be allowed on the website (www.wbhrb.in) between 15.10.2020 to 04.11.2020 (before 8 PM).

Posts are temporary but likely to be permanent.

The relevant rules and necessary particulars are stated in the following paragraphs:

A candidate should verify from the notified rules that he/she is eligible for selection. The condition prescribed cannot be relaxed in any manner. The recruitment shall be made by selection, but where a large number of applications are received as a result of Advertisement, the Board may, for the purpose of short-listing, hold a preliminary examination.

Qualification :

i) For the post of Assistant professor in psychiatric Epidemiology :

- i) MBBS Degree included in the First Scheduled or Second Schedule or Part -II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956) and Requisite Post Graduate qualification* in the Epidemiology/ Health Science/ Public Health.(Master in Public Health Epidemiology/ Applied Epidemiology); *Post Graduate Qualification also includes MS (Master of Science) in Health Sciences even from any Foreign University
- ii) At least (01) year experience in Psychiatric Epidemiology in Recognized Institute of national Repute;

Note I. - Weightage shall be given to the candidates with training in Child Psychiatry/ Psychiatric medicine.

Note II. - Weightage shall be given to the candidates for publication in journal indexed Medicus or Journals at the National level of National Academic Organisation.

iii) For the post of Demonstartor in Psychiatric Epidemiology

MBBS degree included in the First Schedule or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956);

Note I. Weightage shall be given to the candidates holding recognized postgraduate degree in Epidemiology/ Health Sciences/ Public Health/ Psychiatry;

Note II. Weightage shall be given to the candidates having two (02) years service experience in Psychiatry;

Note III Weightage shall be given to the candidates for publication in journal indexed with Index Medicus or Journals at the National Level of National Academic Organisation.

Age:

i) For the post of Assistant professor in psychiatric Epidemiology : Not more than 50 years as on 1st January 2020.

ii) For the post of Demonstartor in Psychiatric Epidemiology : Not more than 45 years as on 1st January 2020.

Age relaxation for both the post may be given to such doctors under this State Government to an extent equivalent to the period of such service, **subject to a maximum of five years.**

Provided that age may also be relaxable for the candidates belong to the categories of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Government Rules or Orders for the time being in force.

N.B

- 1) The applicant must be a citizen of india or such a person of other nationality as declared eligible by Govt. of India;
- 2) Age as recorded in Madhyamaik or Equivalent certificate will only be acceptable ;
- 3) The claim of candidates for relaxation of age as a Govt. employee should be supported by a certificate from the appropriate authority showing the period of his/her continuous service under Government and the same should be furnished when called for;
- 4) Candidates must fulfill the essential qualifications by the closing date.

Fee: Candidates must submit online the application fee amounting to Rs. 210/- (Rupees two hundred ten only) by net Banking only in any Bank Participating in the GRIPS (Govt. Receipt Information Portal System), Govt. of West Bengal under the Head of Account '0051-00-104-002-16'.

It may please be noted tha tafter making payment to bank, Candidate has to log in to the website with the log in ID & password, already provided to him/her after registration through SMS/E mail for payment verification and filling up the Page 2 of the Application Form.

Money Order, Cheque, Bank Draft, Cash etc. shall not be acceptable.

No application shall be considered unless accompanied with the requisite application fee.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST of West Bengal and persons with disabilities specified under Disabilities Rule, 1999 (certificates obtained before the Advertisement date) are not required to pay any fee. Such exemption of fee is, however, not applicable to any OBC (Category A or B) candidate.

No claim for refund of the fee shall be entertained nor will it be held reserved for any other examination.

Application shall be made in the format, as available, in the West Bengal Health Recruitment Board Website (www.wbhrb.in).

Application received after the closing date shall be rejected.

In case, any of the statements made in the application be subsequently found to be false within the knowledge of the candidates, his/her candidature shall be liable to cancellation, and even if appointed to a post on the basis of the results of this examination, his/her appointment shall be liable to be terminated. Willful suppression of any material fact will also be similarly dealt with.

Candidates should take particular note that entries in their application submitted to the Board must be made correctly against all the items which shall be treated as final and no alteration and addition in this regard will be entertained after submission of the application. **Application not duly filled in or found incomplete or defective in any respect or without fee will be liable to rejection.**

Candidates must fulfill the essential qualification by the closing date.

(B) Persons with Disabilities (PWD) [40% and above] must produce a certificate from an appropriate Medical Board [vide West Bengal Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1999]

(C) The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board (WBHRB) may require such further proof or particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries regarding eligibility. Original Certificates relating to citizenship (by registration), age, qualifications, caste (SC/ST/BC), Physical disability (40% and above). Shall have to be submitted when the WBHRB asks for. If any candidate fails to furnish any certificate or any other relevant document or information relating to his/her candidature within the time specified by the Board, his/her claim for allotment may be passed over without further reference to the candidate.

A candidate should note that his/her admission to the Examination/ Interview will be deemed provisional subject to determination of his/her eligibility in all respects.
