			<b>TOTAL: 56.00%-65.99% = 65</b>	If 60% is to be considered as an average mark then the slab should be 56% to 65% because within the last 9 years period of time the University had been changed from University of Calcutta to West Bengal University of Health Sciences and similarly the pattern of marks has also been changed to a higher percentage.
			<b>TOTAL: 66.00%-75.99% = 70</b>	As because 75% mark is being consider as an honours mark then it can be judge as 66% to 75% a good mark.
