Online Applications are invited from Indian Citizens and such other nationals as declared eligible by the Government of India for recruitment to the posts of Professor (Non-Medical) & Asstt. Professor (Non-Medical) in WBS Cadre for the Centre of Liver Research, SDLD, IPGMER, SSKM, Kolkata.

Posts are temporary but likely to be permanent.

**The relevant rules and necessary particulars are stated in the following paragraphs:**

A candidate should verify from the notified rules that he/she is eligible for selection. The condition prescribed cannot be relaxed in any manner. The recruitment shall be made by selection, but where a large number of applications are received as a result of Advertisement, the Board may, for the purpose of short-listing, hold a preliminary examination.

- (i) **Essential :** 1. A. Master's Degree with at least of 55% of the marks or its equivalent Grade of B in the seven point scale with latter grades O, A,B,C,D,E. & F in Physiology or Biochemistry or Microbiology or Biotechnology or in any branch in Life Science;  
2. Ph.D. from a recognized University;  
3. A minimum of ten years post Ph.D. research experience;  
4. At least fifteen research publications in indexed journals.  
5. Experience in supervising research projects of Department of Science and Technology or other projects funded by the Central Government or the State Government;  
6. Knowledge of Bengali (Reading, writing and speaking); ‘

**Name of the post : Assistant Professor (Non-Medical)**

Not more than thirty-two years on the **1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2020** relaxable for otherwise well qualified candidate or person already in Government service.

Age relaxation may be given to such teachers under this State Government an extent equivalent to the period of such service, **subject to a maximum of five years.**

Provided further that upper age limit may also be relaxed for the candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Government Rules or Orders issued for the time being in force.

Such exemption of fee is, however, not applicable to any OBC (Category A or B) candidate.

- (b) Persons with Disabilities (Physically Handicapped) [40% and above] must have a certificate from an appropriate Medical Board [vide West Bengal Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1999]
- (c) The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board (WBHRB) may require such further proof or particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries regarding eligibility.
