### **Direct recruitment to the Lecturer in the West Bengal Homoeopathic Education Service under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal**

Online applications are invited from Indian Citizen and such other nationals as declared eligible by the Government of India for recruitment to the Post of **Lecturer in the West Bengal Homoeopathic Education Service** under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal.

Only online registration & submission of Application shall be allowed on the website ([www.wbhrb.in](http://www.wbhrb.in)) between **17.09.2019 to 24.09.2019 (before 8 PM)**.

Posts are temporary but likely to be permanent.

**The relevant rules and necessary particulars are stated in the following paragraph:**

A candidate should verify from the notified rules that he/she is eligible. The condition prescribed can not be relaxed. The recruitment will be made by selection, but where a large number of applications are received, as a result of Advertisement, the Board may, for the purpose of short-listing, hold a preliminary examination.

**Scale of Pay:** PB-4A, Rs.15,600/- --- Rs.42,000/-, Grade Pay – Rs. 5400/-, Other allowances are admissible as per existing Government Rules.

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#### **Qualification:**

- Essential for Lecturer in Homoeopathic Subjects namely, Organon of Medicine, Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Homoeopathic Pharmacy, Repertory.:**

Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy, preferably in the concerned Subject. The qualification shall be the one included in the Second Schedule of Homoeopathy Central

Council Act, 1973. Preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as RMO and /or House Physicians in a Homoeopathic Hospital attached to a Homoeopathic Medical College permitted by the Central Council/Central Government: Provided that the preference may be given to the persons who have rendered at least two years service in rural areas.

**2) Essential in subjects namely, Anatomy, Physiology, Pathology, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Surgery, Gynaecology and Obstetrics, Practice of Medicine and Community Medicine.**

Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy, preferably in the concerned Subject. The qualification shall be the one included in the Second Schedule of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973. Preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as RMO and /or House Physicians in a Homoeopathic Hospital attached to a Homoeopathic Medical College permitted by the Central Council/Central Government

OR

Post Graduate Medical Degree in the concerned subject recognized by the Medical Council of India. Preference shall be given to those candidates who hold experience of working as R.M.O. and/or House Physicians in a Hospital attached to a Medical College permitted by Medical Council/Central Government.

Provided that the preference may be given to the persons who have rendered at least two years service in rural areas.

**Age :** Not more than 40 years as on the Last Date of receipt of Application for the Post. Age is relaxable by 5 years maximum for exceptionally qualified persons with prior approval of the University concerned: Provided that the Upper Age may be relaxable for the candidates belonging to the categories of Schedule Castes, Schedule Tribes and other Backward Classes as per Government order for the time being in force.

**Fee :** Candidates must submit the application fee amounting to Rs. 210 (Rupees TWO hundred & TEN) only through Banks participating in the GRPS ( Govt. Receipt Portal System ), Govt. of West Bengal under the Head of Account '0051-00-104-002-16'.

***Money order, Cheque, Bank Draft, Cash etc. shall not be acceptable.***

No application shall be considered unless accompanied with the requisite application fee excepting Candidates belonging to SC/ST category of West Bengal and persons with disabilities specified under Disabilities Rule, 1999 (certificates obtained before the Advertisement date), who do not require to pay any fee. Such exemption of fee is, however, not applicable to any OBC (category A or B) candidate.

**No claim for refund of the fee shall be entertained nor shall it be held in reserved for any other examination.**

Application received after the closing date shall be rejected.

In case, any of the statement made in the application be subsequently found to be false within the knowledge of the candidates- his/her candidature shall be liable to cancellation, and even if appointed to a post on the results of this examination his/her appointment shall be liable to be terminated. Willful suppression of any material fact shall also be similarly dealt with.

Candidates should take particular note that entries in their application submitted to the Board must be made correctly against all the items which shall be treated as final and no alteration and addition in this regard shall be entertained after full submission of the application. Application not duly filled in or found incomplete or defective in any respect or without fee will be liable to rejection.

*No claim for being a member of the SC, ST and OBC, or a Person with Disability shall be entertained after submission of the application.*

- (b) Persons with Disabilities (Physically handicapped) [ 40% and above ] must have a certificate from an appropriate Medical Board [vide West Bengal Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1999]

- (c) The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board (WBHRB) may require such further proof or particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries regarding eligibility.

Original Certificates relating to citizenship (by registration), age, qualifications, caste (SC/ST/OBC), Physical disability (40% and above) shall have to be submitted when the WBHRB asks for them. If any candidate fails to furnish any certificate or any other relevant document or information relating to his/her candidature within the time specified by the Board, his/her claim for allotment may be passed over without further reference to him/her.

*Submission of more than one application is strictly forbidden.*

A candidate should note that his/her admission to the Examination/ Interview shall be deemed provisional subject to determination of his/her eligibility in all respects. If at any stage even after issue of the letter of appointment a candidate is found ineligible for admission to this Examination, his/her candidature shall be cancelled without further reference to him/her.

4.(i) Possession of **teaching experience in the concerned subject - 3 marks for each completed year** in a recognized institute = **Maximum- 15 marks**

(ii) Possession of **teaching experience in other than concerned subject** in a recognized Institute – **2 marks for each completed year, Maximum- 10 marks**

5. Publication in Peer Reviewed Journal (Not dissertation or college magazine or souvenirs)- **1 marks for each publication, Maximum- 5 marks**
